


CONTROL POINTS

<p>A permanent and elected state institution in Latvia, whose duties include preparation and management of the Latvian Parliament, 1 (<u>name of EU institution</u>), and municipal elections, as well as referenda and proposing laws.</p> <p>The next elections for this EU institution will take place in Latvia and in other EU Member States in May 2019. In Latvia, we will have to elect 2 (<u>how many?</u>) Members.</p>		<p>A cultural monument of national importance included in the UNESCO World Heritage List. Its foundation stone was laid in 1211. The building complex includes features of Romanesque, early Gothic, Baroque, and Art Nouveau.</p> <p>An ambitious repair and reconstruction of the object was carried out with the help of co-financing from EU funds.</p>	
<p>The edifice built in the second quarter of the 14th century is considered to be the largest and relatively well-preserved medieval fortification in the Baltic States. It is also a restored cultural monument. With the development of the Latvian State, the front castle buildings become official residence for 3 (<u>who?</u>).</p>		<p>The main building was built according to the project of the Baltic-German architect 4 (<u>name and surname</u>) from 1903 to 1905. It is one of the most impressive buildings of the Historicism style on the Riga boulevard circle and an architectural monument of national importance.</p> <p>Between 2013 and 2015, the largest reconstruction, restoration and modernisation of the 111 year-old building took place with the co-financing of more than EUR 13 million from the European Regional Development Fund.</p>	
<p>The eclecticism-style building is an architectural and artistic monument of national importance; the Latvian State was 8 (<u>verb</u>) in this building in 18 November 1918.</p>		<p>This institution ensures that the people in Latvia should have a secure and valuable currency and long-term stability. Since 2014, it decides on development policy of the common European currency together with the institutions of other EU Member States in 7 (<u>name</u>) zone.</p>	

<p>One of the institutions involved in the Days of European Cultural Heritage.</p> <p>In Latvia, these activities are devoted to the establishment and development of Republic of Latvia. The participation of this institution symbolises the country's restoration and integration into the international structures, including its full membership in the European Union.</p>		<p>These buildings are the oldest residential housing complex in Riga. The title is based on the similarity to the Three Sisters, a group of warehouses in the old town of Tallinn. The first confectionery in Riga was established in the building in 1687. It is now home to Latvia's 10 <u>(name)</u> Museum and National Cultural Heritage Administration.</p> <p>The year 2018 has been declared the year of 11 <u>(name)</u>.</p>
<p>The institution was founded by one of the first Latvian professional painters 5 <u>(forename and surname)</u> (1872-1945). It is located in one of the most significant architectural monuments of the start of the 20th century Riga, the Neo-Gothic Stock Exchange Commercial School building (architect Vilhelms Bokslafs).</p> <p>Already for 15 years, the objectives of the European Union programme 6 <u>(name)</u> have been successfully implemented here. Over the years, the institution has set up partnerships with more than 100 universities across Europe, and several hundred students and staff have been on study and practice visits abroad.</p>		<p>The building was constructed for the Vidzeme knighthood in 1863—1867 according to the project of the Baltic German architect Robert Pflug and the first academically educated Latvian architect Jānis Baumanis.</p> <p>In 1990, following the restoration of the independence of the Republic of Latvia, the building was used by the Supreme Council of the Republic of Latvia, followed by 9 <u>(name of institution)</u> which has been here ever since.</p>
